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"These are honest, flavorful wines, offered at what can only be called consumer-friendly prices when compared to other Napa Valley wines.

The composition of the Hendry Red Wine has evolved over the years, from a 60% Malbec offering in its first vintage (2001) to more Cabernet Sauvignon these days. The 2021 Red Wine is a blend of 43% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% each Malbec and Merlot, 17% Petit Verdot and 4% Cabernet Franc. It's a solid value in the Napa context, combining ripe berries and cherries with some slightly leafy elements on the nose, while the full-bodied palate is dusty and reasonably grippy, with those tannins joined by mouthwatering acids on the long finish."
