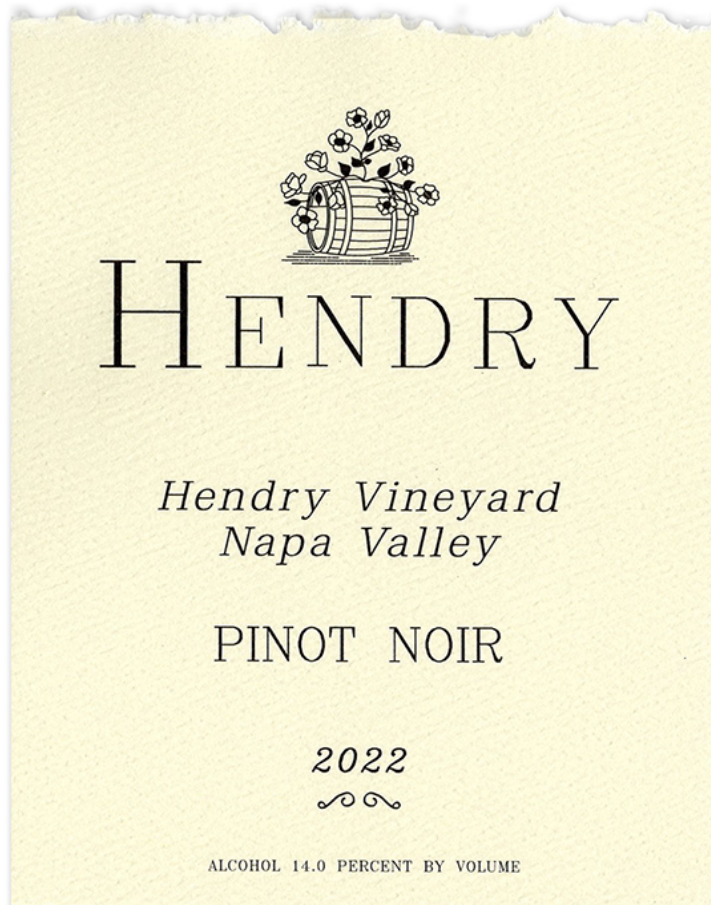

92 HENDRY 2022 PINOT NOIR

Hendry isn't that far north of Carneros, so the idea of Pinot Noir here isn't outlandish. Originally planted in 1972, the blocks have since been replanted to a mix of Dijon clones and a Swan selection. Uninoculated and aged 11 months in 50% new French oak, the 2022 Pinot Noir is a medium to full-bodied, silky, plushly textured offering, marked by scents of black cherries and potpourri, with a touch of persimmon on the lingering finish. Drink 2024-2030.
